



Do you own a car you no longer need, or that doesn't run? Donate it to the Carnegie Center! Carnegie receives partial proceeds from vehicle donations through a partnership with Vehicles for Charity (VFC), another nonprofit. VFC accepts the donation on our behalf, fixes the car if needed, and sends it to auction. The donor pays none of these costs. Carnegie receives 80% of the auction proceeds, and VFC receives the other 20%.

It's quick, simple, and free for the donor. Everyone's a winner!

Make your donation in 3 easy steps:

- 1** You will need only 5 minutes to complete step one. You can either:
 - Visit Carnegie's Vehicles for Charity webpage and complete the form at <https://www.vehiclesforcharity.org/Donate/CLCL.html>. You will need a photograph or scan of your car's title (front and back as separate files) and information including VIN number, mileage, and info on the car title. A representative from Vehicles for Charity will call you to confirm details and help you with the next steps.
 - OR, call 1-866-628-CARS (1-866-628-2277). You should have your VIN number, mileage, and car title ready when then they ask for this information.
- 2** Vehicles for Charity will have a local tow truck company contact you to arrange to pick up your vehicle, at your house, at a time that is convenient for you—you don't need to take your vehicle anywhere, and you don't pay the towing fee, either. **The vehicle can usually be picked up within 2-4 business days.**
- 3** Your vehicle may receive repairs—at the expense of VFC—to prepare it for auction. Then, once it's auctioned, you will receive a tax letter from Vehicles For Charity, although Carnegie will receive a majority of the sale proceeds. According to the VFC website, the **tax-deductible value** is "the value of your vehicle up to \$500, [or] the amount VFC sells your vehicle if sold for more than \$500. Please consult a tax advisor to determine your tax benefit."
